


## How do we acknowledge SOARing at Yugumbir?



## 1. SOARing each day = Class Rewards:

- Students are acknowledged for SOARing during learning time and during lunch and play breaks.
- Each year-level has a consistent process, with students earning points, tallies, coupons or stickers.
- When students have earned enough to trade, they are able to select a prize from the class menu. This may be a small item such as a sparkly pencil, a handball or a toy, or an experience such as sitting at the VIP table, using the teacher's chair for the day, wearing dress-ups or slippers in class or meeting with their Deputy Principal for a picnic. Ask your child what is on their class menu!
- Teachers also award Student of the Week certificates, and send postcards to students who SOAR.

### 2. SOARing all day = Pilot Points:

#### How do students earn their daily Pilot Point?

- **Be at school and SOARing.** Each student who is at school and SOARing will earn one Pilot Point each day. All students also receive a Pilot Point on public holidays. (Maximum of 5 points per student per week).
- Ensure absences are explained to the school administration (not the class teacher) on the day of absence. Students who are absent will earn a Pilot Point if their absence is explained to the school's administration by parent / carer on the day of absence. - Wear formal uniform on Mondays. Please note that on Mondays, students must be wearing their formal school uniform in order to earn a Pilot Point for that day. Students will not earn a Pilot Point on Mondays if they are in sports uniform unless their class has their scheduled PE lesson on that day.

Class teachers record each student's Pilot Points on a class spreadsheet, and students are able to track their points.

# 3. SOARing all term = Invitation to SOAR Celebrations and House Celebrations:

- Each term, students who earn at least 40 Pilot Points by the day of their celebration will be invited to attend their year-level's Celebration of SOARing event.
- Students also receive their 'Pilot Wings' for every SOAR Celebration they attend. (Bronze, Silver, Gold and Diamond certificates available).
- Year-level celebration is held in Week 10 of each term.
- House Celebration is held on the last Friday of term. Pilot Points accumulate for each house until the last Thursday of term.
- Progressive House Totals are displayed on the House board near the tuckshop, and posted weekly to Facebook.

#### Remember, to earn a daily Pilot Point students need to achieve the following:
