Dress Code at Yugumbir State School

The Yugumbir State School community has chosen to adopt a Dress Code consisting of:

- o A dress standard and
- Items of clothing that comprise a school uniform for students that applies when:
 - Attending and representing the school
 - Travelling to and from school
 - Engaging in school activities outside of school hours.



The School Dress Code has purpose

- 1. Our Dress Code contributes to a safe and supportive teaching and learning environment through:
 - Ready identification of students and non-students at school
 - Fostering a sense of belonging
 - Developing mutual respect among students by minimising visible evidence of economic or social difference
- 2. Our Dress Code reflects our school community's ethos of:



- Bringing divergent groups and individuals together as one identity
- Aspiring to excellence: the underlying approach for success at school
- A means for each and every student to have a strong sense of pride and belonging regardless of social or economic difference that a dress standard conveys
- Acknowledging the sufficient opportunity arises in social contexts outside of school where personal and individual preferences can be exercised. This includes their personal appearance such as jewellery, make-up, and hair colours inconsistent with this dress standard.

The School Dress Code is consistent

- a) **Hair**
 - Hair is to be neat, clean and tidy
 - Long hair is to be tied back and out of the eyes
 - No students are to have extreme hair styles
 - Hair should be natural in one colour only
 - Flamboyant or decorative pins, clips, hair extensions or accessories are not to be worn. Hair ties, scrunchies, ribbons, hijabs or turbans must be either Navy blue, maroon, black, white or grey.

b) Jewellery

- To not exceed 1 wristwatch, 1 small discreet ring, 1 set of small sleeper/stud earrings (additional clear piercings are not permitted)
- Medical discs may be worn
- Jewellery of religious/cultural significance is not to be visible
- · Facial piercings are not permitted, including clear piercings

c) Make-up and nails

- Make-up is not permitted
- Nail polish is to be colourless
- Acrylic and gel nails are not permitted

d) Shoes and socks

- · Preferably plain black, low cut leather or sport lace up shoes
- Velcro straps in younger years for students who are unable to tie laces.
- Plain white or navy socks

e) Formal Uniform

• All students are required to wear their formal uniforms on Monday and when representing the school.

f) Sport House (colours) Uniform

- Sports days and PE lessons
- Athletics carnival
- Swimming days
- House specific events





g) Hats

- Full brimmed, bucket hat or the Yugumbir cap is to be worn for any and all outdoor play and sports activities
- · Preferred bucket hat is available in reversible Sport House colours



h) Winter uniforms

- □ The following additional navy pieces may be worn during winter. These pieces are available at local retail stores as alternative options.
 - i. Navy skivvy (worn under shirt)
 - ii. Navy leggings
 - iii. Plain navy track suit pants
 - iv. Plain navy jumper
 - v. Navy stockings
