Uniform Policy at Yugumbir State School

The Yugumbir State School community has chosen to adopt a Uniform Policy consisting of:

- A dress standard, and
- Items of clothing that comprise a school uniform for students that applies when:
 - Attending and representing the school
 - Travelling to and from school
 - Engaging in school activities outside of school hours.

The School Uniform Policy has purpose.




Our Uniform Policy contributes to a safe and supportive teaching and learning environment by:

- Allowing for ready identification of students and non-students at school
- Fostering a sense of belonging for our students
- Developing mutual respect among students by minimising visible evidence of economic or social difference

Our Uniform Policy reflects our school community's ethos of:

- Bringing divergent groups and individuals together as one identity
- Aspiring to excellence: the underlying approach for success at school
- Supporting each and every student to have a strong sense of pride and belonging regardless of social or economic difference, conveyed by a consistent dress standard
- Acknowledging that sufficient opportunity arises in social contexts outside of school where personal and individual preferences can be exercised. This includes their personal appearance such as jewellery, make-up, and hair colours inconsistent with this dress standard.

The School Uniform Policy is explicit, with three required uniforms:

The School Uniform Policy is consistent:

Uniform, winter wear, hat, shoes, socks, hair, jewellery, make-up and nail expectations are consistent across whole of school.

Please ensure all items are clearly named.

Uniform

- See required days of wear above and images below.

Hat

- Full-brimmed bucket hat or Yugumbir cap to be worn for any and all outdoor play and sports activities
- Preferred bucket hat is available in reversible Sport House colours

Shoes and socks

- Preferably plain black, low-cut leather or sports lace up shoes
- Velcro straps are suitable in younger years for students who are unable to tie laces.
- Plain white or navy socks

Winter wear

All winter items are to be plain and navy in colour, without logos or embellishments.

Students may wear:

- Yugumbir jumper OR Yugumbir zip jacket OR plain navy jumper
- Plain navy track pants
- Navy skivvy (worn under shirt)
- Navy leggings, tights or stockings

Yugumbir jumpers and jackets can be purchased at the Uniform Shop, and plain navy items are available at local retail stores as alternative options. Hoodies are not permitted.

Hair

- Hair is to be neat, clean and tidy
- Long hair, once long enough to touch the shoulders, is to be tied back and out of the eyes
- Hair should be natural colour only
- Students are not to have extreme hair styles
- Hair ties, scrunchies, ribbons, hijabs or turbans must be navy blue, maroon, black, white or grey. Flamboyant or decorative pins, clips, hair extensions or accessories are not to be worn.

Jewellery

- To be no more than one wristwatch and/or one set of small sleeper/stud earrings. Additional clear piercings are not permitted.
- Medical identification items may be worn
- Jewellery of religious or cultural significance is to be not visible, eg tucked inside shirt
- Facial piercings are not permitted, including clear piercings

Make-up and nails

- Make-up is not permitted
- Nail polish is to be colourless
- Acrylic and gel nails are not permitted
